1st ANNOUNCEMENT AND CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS First PSIP Workshop 2009

Adverse DrugEvents, Human Factors, IT Tool For Patient Medication Safety.
Belgirate, Lake Maggiore, Italy, September 24-25, 2009 www.psip-project.eu

Goal of Workshop:

Adverse Drug Events (ADEs) endanger patients’ safety and instigate considerable extra hospital costs. Therefore, a significant reduction of preventable ADEs is a challenging issue in Public Health.

To that end, the PSIP project will provide innovative tools giving relevant knowledge to healthcare professionals and patients by means of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT). The objective of this Workshop is to present methods, results and to discuss the following topics:

1. Identification of ADE and medication errors in hospital settings: Chart analysis, Record analysis, statistical analysis, Data Mining of structured hospital databases and Semantic Mining of data collections of free-texts (letters, reports);
2. The role of Human and Organisational factors on ADE and medication errors: Observations, analysis of work situations, Modelling of the organization, the tasks and the users activity; Error analysis;
3. The ICT solutions to prevent or correct ADEs and medications errors: alerts, decision support systems, contextualised solutions, Web information.

Papers from the PSIP project and from international research at top level will be presented and discussed in a two day Workshop.

Scope:

We seek high-quality, original long papers, that address the above mentioned issues, in particular, human error, safety, and system development. This Workshop will, therefore, provide a forum for practitioners and researchers to discuss leading edge techniques that can be used to mitigate the impact of ADE on safety-critical systems.

With this in mind, we hope to address a number of different themes like and the expected papers cover the following topics, but not limited to:

- Patient safety and quality of care
- Adverse Drug Events
- Medication errors
- Data Mining and semantic mining
- Decision Support Systems
- Human Factors In Health Systems

Submissions:

Paper submission should follow the following procedure:

Full paper submissions (6-10 pages) should describe substantial contributions of novel ongoing work that has produced advanced results. Accepted submissions, following a peer review process, will be presented during parallel sessions, and will be included in the Conference Proceedings.
